1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

3. POLICE REPORT

The Clerk advised that there had been a reduction by 19% in crime in Station Town and 50% in Hutton Henry. ASB had reduced by 69% in Station Town and 99% in Hutton Henry.

a) C24 Hurworth Burn Road – Temporary Road Closure

b) Urgent Care Centre

A consultation was ongoing around proposals to change the times the urgent treatment centre in Peterlee was open. Usage of the service was low between 12 midnight and 8am. Proposals were to deliver the service in a slightly different way. There was an online survey for comments to the proposals.
